Special Show Best Breeder Rules:

- 1. Participation in Special Show Best Breeder is free of charge.
- 2. The title of Best Breeder will be awarded to the exhibitor who is also the breeder of at least 1 cat presented on the show, and when at least 3 cats with his cattery name take part in the show, including at least 1 cat in class 11 or 12.
- 3. The Best Breeder is the sum of the results obtained at the show on May 20 (Saturday) by 3 cats with the same cattery name, including one cat in class 11 or 12 and 1 cat whose breeder is also the exhibitor.
- 4. If more than 3 cats from one cattery take part in the show, the results of the best 3 cats are counted for Best Breeder, including 1 breeder's cat and 1 cat in class 11 or 12.
- 5. BIV is not included in the results.
- 6. Points: BOB 30 nomBIS -20, CACS/CAPS/HP -10, CAGCIB/CAPIB 8, CACIB/CAPIB -6 CAC/CAP -4, EX1-4
- 7. The awarding of the title of Best Breeder will take place on Sunday, before the BIS

SHOW RULES AND CONDITIONS

- All FIFe rules are valid and applicable.
- Judges decisions are final and cannot be protested.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the health and behaviour of their cats at all times.
- Exhibitors or persons authorized by them may present the cats to the judges themselves but the steward will always be at your disposition.
- For BIS cats are presented only by stewards.
- Cats must be in decorated cages until the exhibition is officially closed.
- Cancellations of cats will only be accepted in writing from the person who entered the cat till
 the closing date for entries.
- House cats must be neutered.
- SELLING CATS and KITTENS during the show is strictly forbidden.
- Litter can not be entry also a show guest
- A request of colour confirmation should be submitted on the form of the exhibition.

VETERINARY CONDITIONS:

- All cats must have a microchip, valid vaccination book and/or pet passport, be healthy and free from infections and parasities.
- It is obligatory for all cats to be vaccinated respiratory viral diseases and panleucopenia at least 15 days but no more than 24 months prior to the show. Kittens / litter / must be vaccinated at least twice to viral diseases, re-vaccination no later than 15 days prior to the show.
- All cats must have a passport
- All white cats must have a veterinary certificate stating that the cat is not deaf. /show rules FiFe art.15
- · All cats must have the tips of their nails cut before the show
